POLICY STATEMENT:

Diploma/BSN/RN to BSN

A student who is eligible to participate in graduation activities and receive the college pin and diploma/degree must:

- Successfully complete the curriculum by earning a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- Submit to the Office of Registration and Enrollment a complete and current transcript of support courses taken while enrolled.
- Complete graduation requirements within 150% of the standard program length.

In no case can a student exceed one and one-half times the number of credits as defined by the college either as a regular student or in an extended enrollment status (granted at the discretion of the college) and receive the original academic credential for which he or she enrolled.

In situations that exceed the maximum time frame, as defined by the maximum standard number of credits, students will be awarded a Certificate of Completion.
