

## **Southside Health Education Foundation (SHEF) Funding** (scholarships and forgivable loans)

### **How to apply:**

You can apply for all their funding on a rolling basis in one easy application:

In addition to your application, you must complete a current FAFSA and provide a copy of your FAFSA Submission Summary (FSS), a copy of your Virginia driver's license/state identification with a zip code that is included in the **SHEF service region** (see map and zip code list below), and proof of enrollment. These documents will need to be forwarded to [info@sheducation.org](mailto:info@sheducation.org)

### To access your FSS:

1. Log in to your [StudentAid.gov](https://studentaid.gov) account Dashboard
2. Select your processed FAFSA submission from the "My Activity" section
3. Select "View FAFSA Submission Summary"
4. Download to your device or print
