The RN-BSN program is an online post-licensure program for the registered nurse who has a valid, unencumbered license to practice nursing in the United States. The program consists of 120 credits and can be completed in as few as three semesters. Once completed, a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree is awarded.

The general education requirements include:

46 credits of general education courses prior to entry

For applicants with bachelor's degree in unrelated field:

- Human Growth & Development (3 cr.)
- Microbiology (4 cr.)
- Anatomy & Physiology I & II (6–8 cr.)
- Statistics (3 cr.)

The remainder of the program consists of:

- 41 credits of prior learning as a registered nurse, which you will be granted upon completion of NUR 3209
- 33 credits of online nursing education courses and general education courses

For applicants with RN licensure only:

46 credits of general education courses prior to entry
