
**Policy Statement:**

Services for students are comprehensive and encompass academic advising, support and life skills. The Office of Student Success partners with nursing faculty and administration in these efforts. The Office of Student Success is comprised of a director, academic advisors and career counselor.

The Office of Student Success oversees academic advising, academic counseling, skill building, tutoring, disability referral and accommodations, needs based programming and support, career services and referrals for personal counseling.

Academic Advising is required of each student. Faculty advisors and academic advisors will work individually with students at the start of their nursing education and throughout their entire academic journey. Academic Advising is designed to build relationships between students and faculty and create a supportive setting in which students can discuss their course selection and progress.
