

Printers/Copiers: Pre-Licensure BSN Student Communication, August 18, 2020

Dear Students:

Earlier this summer, the College announced that we will be moving to a pay-per-print model for all copiers on campus. While we are still working through that transition, we continue to adapt to the evolving health guidelines in relation to institutions of higher education during the pandemic. It is with your safety in mind that we have decided to suspend any student print/copy use on campus as an added health and security measure. Suspending student use of copiers helps maintain sanitization in the building and further reduces the number of students on campus. These steps help reduce the spread of COVID-19 and further ensures our College stays open. This suspension applies to the entire campus, including the library.

While we recommend students employ alternative methods to printing, such as electronic note taking, having access to a personal printer is required this academic year, and is outlined in the Technology Requirements document that was referenced in the [June 30 communication](#). Technology requirements are updated annually and are posted to the [website](#) and are included in the [College Catalog](#).

Printing is, of course, a personal choice and not a curricular requirement. If you choose to print and do not own a personal printer, many businesses offer those services, including local UPS or FedEx Office stores, which offer printing/copying services for a fee.

We know this is a change and appreciate your support. The health and safety of the campus community remains our priority.
