


BSMCON THREE-YEAR ENROLLMENT DEMOGRAPHICS






BSMCON THREE-YEAR 100%, 150% & 200% PRE-LICENSURE GRADUATION RATES

Graduation rates in the tables below are defined as follows (all semester counts exclude summer):

- 100% or on-time graduation rate is graduation within 8 semesters for pre-licensure students and within 4 semesters for post-licensure students
- 150% graduation rate is graduation within 12 semesters for pre-licensure students and within 6 semesters for post-licensure students.
- 200% graduation rate is graduation within 16 semesters for pre-licensure students and within 8 semesters for post-licensure students.






BSMCON THREE-YEAR 100%, 150% & 200% POST-LICENSURE GRADUATION RATES


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BSMCON THREE-YEAR FIRST-TIME NCLEX PASS RATES
